Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the 10th Street Multimodal Safety Enhancements project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Greeley, located at 1200 11th Ave, Greeley, CO 80634.

This funding would be used to install safety and operational improvements along Greeley's two-mile corridor of 10th Street between 71st Avenue and 47th Avenue, including narrowing the roadway, removing acceleration lanes, and introducing a defined median to better align driver expectations with surrounding land uses. These improvements are designed to reduce speeds, enhance safety, and support safer mobility and connectivity for all roadway users along a corridor that has experienced multiple fatal and severe injury crashes. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will enhance roadway safety, reduce crash risk, and improve mobility and connectivity along a high-traffic corridor in a rapidly growing community.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
