Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Neville's Crossing Non-Potable Pond and System Rehabilitation project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Evans, located at 1100 37th Street, Evans, Colorado 80620.

The funding would be used to strengthen the City's non-potable water infrastructure system by addressing the risks associated with the underground pump station and control room and protecting critical operational infrastructure. In addition, the City will reduce seepage and improve water retention to ensure a more reliable supply of non-potable water for irrigation purposes by removing vegetation and relining the pond. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will enhance the City's ability to maintain reliable non-potable water infrastructure, reduce system vulnerabilities, and support efficient irrigation and resource management.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
