Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Public Safety Center Roof and Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Replacement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Westminster, located at 4800 West 92nd Avenue, Westminster, CO 80031.

This funding would be used to replace the aging roof and HVAC system at the City of Westminster's Public Safety Center, a 70,000 square-foot facility that houses critical services including police and fire administration, patrol operations, investigations, 911 emergency dispatch, the crime lab, mental health co-responder services, victim services, records, evidence storage, animal management, and temporary holding facilities. These improvements will ensure continuity of essential public safety operations, protect sensitive evidence and records, and provide a safe, reliable environment for personnel in a facility whose infrastructure has exceeded its useful life. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will maintain critical public safety infrastructure that will serve the Westminster community for years to come.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
